- Area Resource Center – a great library of discipleship books, videos, etc.

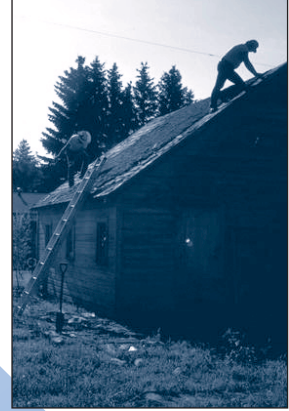
THE NEED:
